

With the **FARCURA** project, we discover various models of social farming and the possibilities of connecting with decision-makers, rural TOPCUTO development org., social and health care org. in order to expand the educational program in the field of social farming.

SUITABLE project aims to gather initiatives for sustainable development in the alpine region, especially national parks. The impacts of climate change, agriculture, tourism, and biodiversity in DE, SI, and FR will be analysed and compared by students.

REWARD — Raising Employability of Women through entrepreneurial **Activities** fostering Rural Development; project objective is to provide the needed training to women living in rural areas in order to be able REWARD to manage multifunctional activities related to agriculture and rural cultural heritage.

TOPPlant educates in the field of biological plant protection. Employs new production techniques in a controlled field using predefined regulations and documenting all stages of production.
